



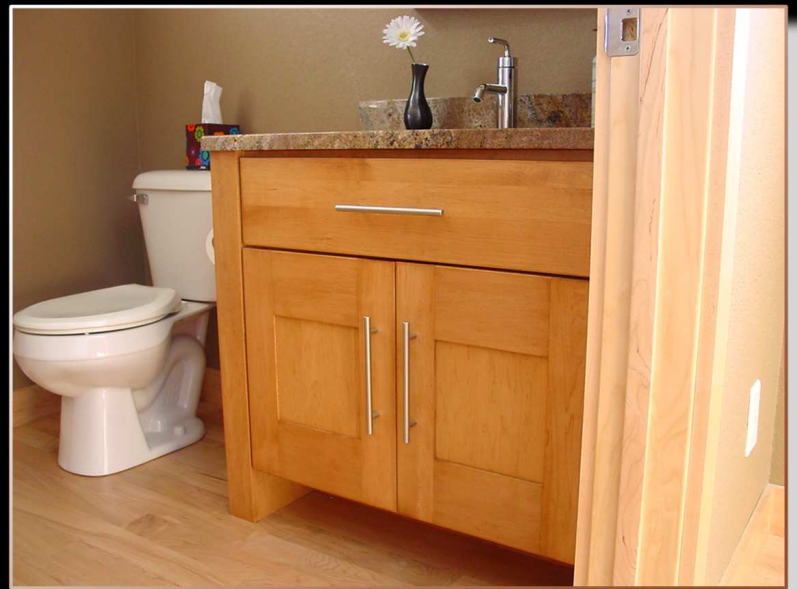

# Maple



The sapwood is creamy white with a slight reddish brown tinge and the heartwood varies from light to dark reddish brown. The amount of darker brown heartwood can vary significantly according to growing region. Both sapwood and heartwood can contain pith fleck. The wood has a close fine, uniform texture and is generally straight-grained, but it can also occur as "curly," "fiddleback," and "birds-eye" figure. Westwood Kitchens offers 11 grades of Maple. Given the customer the most possible options in the industry. We offer all White Hard Maple to a Rustic Soft Maple with knots as large as possible and everything in between.



# Hickory

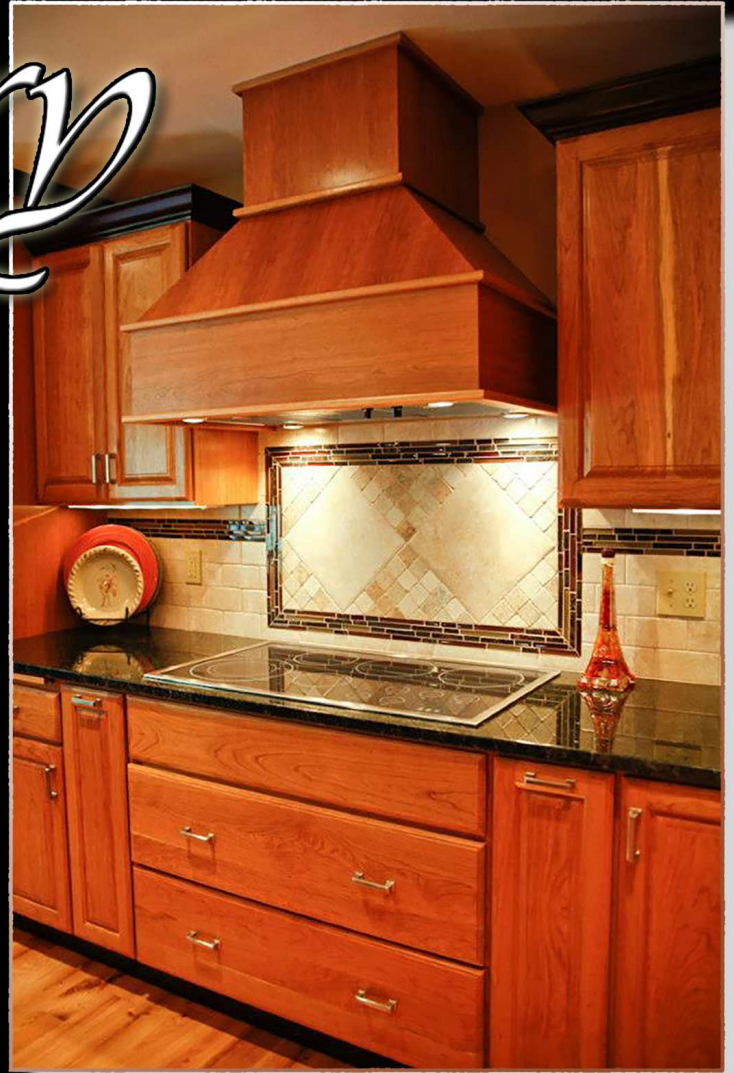


Hickory is very hard, stiff, dense and shock resistant. There are woods that are stronger than hickory and woods that are harder, but the combination of strength, toughness, hardness and stiffness found in hickory wood is not found in any other commercial wood.\*\* Westwood Kitchens offers 13 different grades of Hickory, giving the customer the most possible options in the industry. We offer all White Hickory to a all Brown Rustic Hickory with knots as large as possible and everything in between.

# Cherry



The heartwood of cherry varies from rich red to reddish brown and will darken with age and on exposure to light. In contrast, the sapwood is creamy white. The wood has a fine uniform, straight grain, satiny, smooth texture, and may naturally contain brown pith flecks and small gum pockets. Westwood Kitchens offers 5 grades of Cherry. Given the customer the most possible options in the industry. We offer all Rich Reddish Brown to a Rustic with knots as large as possible and everything in between.



# Birch



White Birch contains very little sapwood-what there is of it appears nearly white. The heartwood color varies from cream to light brown tinged with red and has a distinct but not overwhelming grain pattern. A wavy figure becomes prominent in veneers. Yellow birch has a white sapwood and light reddish brown heartwood. The wood is generally straight-grained with a fine uniform texture. Generally characterized by a plain and often curly or wavy pattern.



# Oak



The sapwood of red oak is white to light brown and the heartwood is a pinkish reddish brown. The wood is similar in general appearance to white oak, but with a slightly less pronounced figure due to the smaller rays. The wood is mostly straight-grained, with a coarse texture. The sapwood of White Oak is light-colored and the heartwood is light to dark brown. White oak is mostly straight-grained with a medium to coarse texture, with longer rays than red oak. White oak therefore has more figure. Westwood Kitchens offers 14 different grades of Oak, giving the customer the most possible options in the industry. We offer Qtr Sawn Red Oak to a Riff Cut White Oak and everything in between.



# Pine

Eastern White Pine heartwood is a light brown, sometimes with a slightly reddish hue, sapwood is a pale yellow to nearly white. Color tends to darken with age. Grain is straight with an even, medium texture. Pine is a softer wood and will naturally add patina as it ages. Westwood Kitchens offers a Knotty Pine and a Natural Pine.



# Alder



Red Alder, a relative of birch, is almost white when freshly cut but quickly changes on exposure to air, becoming light brown with a yellow or reddish tinge. Heartwood is formed only in trees of advanced age and there is no visible boundary between sap and heartwood. The wood is fairly straight-grained with a uniform texture. Westwood Kitchens offers a Natural Alder and a Rustic Alder.

# Our Quality Cabinet Construction Features



- 1 → 5 piece drawer box and roll out shelves are constructed of 5/8" hardwood, dovetailed at the corners with 1/4" bottoms that are dadoed into all of sides for strength and durability.
- 2 → Self-closing drawer slides featuring Blumotion soft close for smooth action and unmatched durability. Made in the USA. Also featuring Blumotion hinges with soft closing features.
- 3 → All shelves are full depth and fully adjustable 3/4" hardwood plywood for storage strength and stability, and are supported with durable metal shelf clips.
- 4 → All roll out shelves are fully adjustable and equipped with protective drawer bumpers which prevent the slide from marring cabinet doors.
- 5 → Finish end panels are 1/2" hardwood plywood, with a matching 1/4" wood veneer exterior skin which are glued on for fasten free appearance.
- 6 → Cabinet backs consist of 1/2" hardwood plywood rabbeted into sides and dadoed to receive the top and bottom.
- 7 → Face frames are mortise and tennon construction, 3/4" solid hardwood of your choice.
- 8 → Top and bottoms of wall cabinets are 1/2" hardwood plywood and are dadoed into sides, backs, and frames.
- 9 → Toe Kick boards are 1/2" hardwood plywood that is supported from behind a maximum of 16" on center. Finished 1/4" toe board cover is available in 8' lengths.
- 10 → Cabinet Doors are solid hardwood with over 40,000 standard styles to choose from.
